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The fabrics, as well as the fire-retardant CMHR polyurethane foam with high density: 60 kg/m³, have been chosen in due consideration of the fact that they should be able to withstand many years of hard daily wear both regarding abrasion resistance, elasticity and cleaning

1. Abrasion resistance

According to the Technical Specifications from Danish Furnituremakers' Quality Control furniture fabrics used on a firm upholstery, which is on all our seating furniture, should fulfil the requirements of an abrasion resistance of 45.000 rubs according to the Martindale test method when exposed to normal use and 75.000 rubs in cases where the furniture is exposed to severe use as for instance in public environments. For less severe use a minimum of 25.000 rubs is needed.

2. Elasticity

On account of the firm upholstery the fibres in the furniture fabric must have a certain degree of elasticity, i.e. the ability to contract after having been used, in order to avoid wrinkles or puckers which may occur when using cotton fabrics lacking this elasticity. In time leather stretches and wrinkles - more on a thick upholstery than on a thinner back upholstery. The thick leather types stretch less than thin leather.

3. Cleaning

As the major part of our seating furniture has a fixed upholstery, it is important that the furniture fabric is dirt-repellent and stands cleaning throughout a long period of time. This applies to woollen fabrics whereas Trevira CS and cotton fabrics attract dirt. This is why removable seat cover should be chosen for seating furniture with a Trevira CS fabric in order to make the seat cover washable. Leather must have a surface treatment.

Steel surfaces
